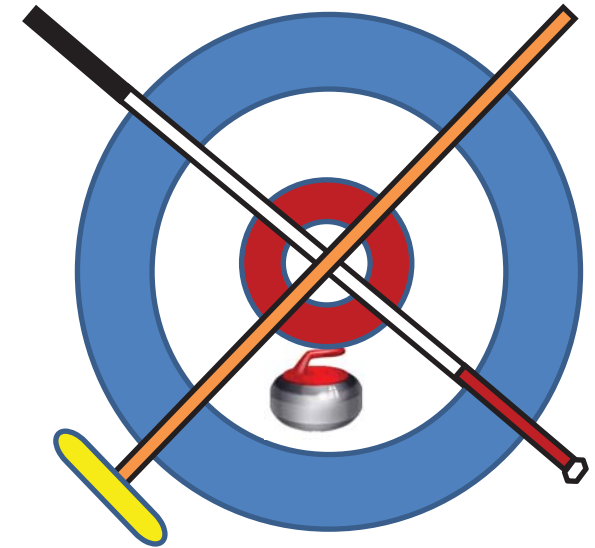

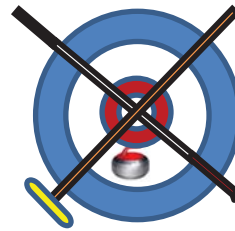
OUR MISSION STATEMENT
